BOARD AGENDA ITEM: Consideration of Approval of Award to Ohno Construction Company for Stadium Sitework at Adolfo Camarillo High School, Bid 608

BACKGROUND

Public Contract Code Section 20111 requires competitive solicitation of public works and construction projects that exceed the bid limit. The District issued a formal public notice inviting bids from pre-qualified contractors for stadium playfield renovation work at Adolfo Camarillo High School. The bids were received on November 13, 2019. This is an approved Measure A modernization project.

ADMINISTRATIVE DISCUSSION

This project will consist of complete replacement of the stadium playfields with artificial turf and running track repairs in areas needed, in coordination with the previously contracted companies providing these materials and their portion of the installations. Adolfo Camarillo High School received a new track in 2017, however, adjacent work will require repairs and re-striping and d-zones will require new surfacing. The project Master Schedule requires completion of the project within 120 days.

Through CMAS Contract #4-12-78-0063A, the track replacement material will be provided by Beynon , A Tarkett Sports Company (Board of Trustees approved Beynon BSS 300 product, Resolutions #18-13 and #19-43).

Through CMAS Contract #4-06-78-0031A, the synthetic turf material will be provided by FieldTurf, A Tarkett Sports Company (Board of Trustees approved Elite FTCORE 2.5 CoolPlay product, Resolution #19-35).

FISCAL IMPLICATION

The cost of the project for stadium sitework is \$3,798,000.00 and will be paid by Measure A Funds.

RECOMMENDATION

It is the recommendation of District Administration that the Board of Trustees approve the presented contract with Ohno Construction Company for Stadium Sitework at Adolfo Camarillo High School, Bid 608, as presented.
